1 Dubrovnik

Itinerary: Days 12-16

Days 12-14: Dubrovnik

Begin with a guided walking tour of the UNESCO-listed Old Town, exploring the limestone-paved Stradun and ancient city walls. Take the cable car to Mount Srđ for panoramic views of the Adriatic Sea and nearby islands. Visit the Maritime Museum and Franciscan Monastery, home to one of Europe's oldest pharmacies. Enjoy free time for swimming at Banje Beach or taking an optional Game of Thrones filming locations tour.

Day 15: Thessaloniki

Morning flight to Thessaloniki, Greece's cultural capital. Explore the bustling Aristotelous Square and historic Ladadika district. Visit the Archaeological Museum to discover Macedonia's golden treasures and ancient artifacts. Walk along the beautiful waterfront promenade to see the iconic White Tower, and explore the UNESCO World Heritage-listed Byzantine churches.

Day 16: Ancient Macedonia
